WHAT YOU'LL NEED

A book you're willing to sacrifice

A wire wreath form

An exacto knife

Elmer's glue or similar

ABOUT THE BIBLIOPHILE MYSTERIES

Welcome to the book-loving world of pre-eminent bookbinder, Brooklyn Wainwright! Brooklyn brings rare books back from the brink of death in her San Francisco workshop. Unfortunately for her, many of the fine books she restores are linked to modern murder, which she feels compelled to investigate with the help of her love, British security expert Derek Stone, and her quirky friends and family.

STEP 1


Cut.

Carefully cut out the pages from the book, using the exacto knife. If the book is fewer than 300 pages or so, you might need a second book of a similar size.

STEP 2

Fold.

Accordion-fold each page from top to bottom, into a strip approximately one-half inch wide. Then fold the strip in half lengthwise.



STEP 3

Glue.

Slide one half of the strip through the wire wreath form. Glue the two halves together so the strip is wrapped around the wire. Repeat steps 1-3 until all the pages are distributed around the wreath.

STEP 4

Decorate.

If you wish, decorate your
Bibliophile Wreath with lightweight
